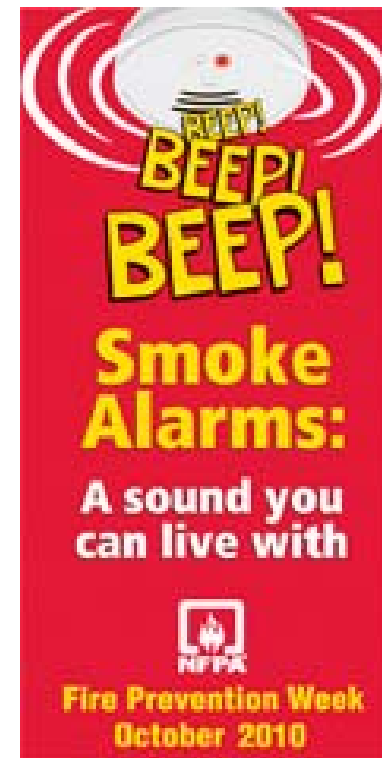

RULES

1. Posters should reflect the following theme: “**Smoke Alarms: A sound you can live with**” on the **FRONT** of the poster.
2. Nothing but the artwork and the theme is to appear on the front of the poster. Attach the registration form (with the student’s information) on the back of the poster. Copies may be made of this form. Posters received other than from the local schools will not be eligible for competition.
3. Posters should promote fire prevention in the community and encourage fire safety awareness in the home and in the school.
4. Posters should not contain television or movie cartoon characters.
5. Posters must not exceed 36 inches by 24 inches.
6. A maximum of four (4) colors are permitted on posters. Black and white are not considered colors. Do not use lead pencil.
7. A panel of judges will select the winning posters based on originality, clarity of message and design. The decision of the judges is final.
8. Posters are to be completed in school, without assistance. (AGE RESTRICTION: Must be under 20 years old prior to May 2010).
9. Only one (1) entry per student.
